"Back in 2009 I saw a documentary about human trafficking, and I left a changed person," Brown said during her <u>interview</u>. "God put it on my heart to dive deep into this issue and what was going on in the community and how I could be a part of stopping it."

In recognition of Brown's professional achievements and contributions to the community, ComGroup made a contribution in her name to <u>Court Appointed Special Advocates</u> (CASA) of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Judicial District, an organization she actively supports.
