Verkamp-Ruthven also leads the refugee program that facilitates the resettlement of newly arrived individuals and families in the community. Following the collapse of the <u>Afghanistan government in</u> 2021, her team assisted a total of 91 Afghan refugees establish a new life in Arkansas.

"It's a relationship of teaching and learning for each one of us, so that's been extremely meaningful," Verkamp-Ruthven said during the <u>episode</u>. "To hear some of those success stories happen and to know that I've played some sort of part in that has been quite the privilege for me."

Verkamp-Ruthven holds a <u>master's degree in social work</u> with a concentration in global practices from <u>Boston College</u>, as well as a bachelor's degree from the <u>University of Arkansas – Fort Smith</u>.

In recognition of Verkamp-Ruthven's professional achievements and contributions to the community, ComGroup donated to <u>Girls' Education Matters (GEM)</u>, an organization she actively supports.
